Absentee Policy

"As members of the University Of Vermont College Of Medicine Student Council, we seek to serve our community to the fullest. With this goal in mind, we expect members to attend all monthly meetings anytime they are an active student. Active students include those participating in rotations at away sites or studying for board exams but excludes students who are on designated vacation time. Should a student have a truly unavoidable conflict while an active student, they are expected to let the President and/or President Elect know why they will not be attending the meeting in order to receive an excused absence. Excused absences include unavoidable academic or clerkship conflicts, personal visits to the physician, weddings, funerals, travel abroad which prohibits skyping in, and other reasons for absence as covered in the College of Medicine Handbook. The list of absent members will be recorded at every meeting, and those who did not contact the President or President Elect will be notified and receive an unexcused absence. Members will be allowed three absences per year without consequence. However, after three absences, members will be put on probation (suspension of voting privileges), and be at risk for dismissal (to be decided by President and President Elect).
