

# Situation Update

- □ **3/18/20**: VDH lab received 391 samples; prioritized & ran 140.
- □ Two (2) new positives
- Current COVID activity in Vermont (note slight format change):

Positive test results	19
Total tests conducted	611
People being monitored	246
People who have completed monitoring	262






## **Practice Implementation Strategies**

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# **Questions/Discussion**

- Q & A Goal: monitor/respond in real time record/ disseminate later as needed (and/or revisit next day).
- □ From 3/18/20 (our best thinking w/o solid evidence):
  - Ibuprofen: no published data; some fake news (that "pts. w/severe COVID-19 exposed to NSAIDs"); WHO evaluating; acetaminophen?
  - Nebs in closed room are aerosol-generating; close room for 2 hours post-procedure. Use MDI/spacer if possible.
  - Prednisone: conflicting info re: use in ADULT COVID-19; prob. not helpful. Children w/asthma exacerbation: don't change current practice – keep using to treat common conditions.
