



[Please note: the COVID-19 situation continues to evolve very rapidly – so the information we're providing may change]

Situation Update

- Surveillance/Laboratory testing: VDH lab running ~120-140 samples/day (clinical prioritization: symptomatic HCWs, hosp. pts., LTC residents, incarcerated individuals, "other high-priority groups").
- Current COVID activity in Vermont (VDH/other PH labs, commercial):

Positive test results*	95
Total tests conducted	1,535
Deaths*	7
People being monitored	339
People who have completed monitoring	316

- UVM MC sending ~600 tests to Mayo daily; results come back to Epic
- Actual (3/25 a.m.): 123 pos. (1535 tests); 7 deaths (no new from 3/23); 19 inpatients statewide (8 confirmed at UVM MC; 8 as PUI)





Recap VMS call w/Dr. Levine (3/24/20)

- "Concerned" re: rise in Vermont case numbers
- Expect Governor Scott's "stay at home" order today [issued 3/24/20]
- High priority tests cont. to VDH lab; others to Mayo/commercial (challenge: test capacity limitations vs. understand community transmission)
- Expects PPE delivery from FEMA not sure what or when (also seeking other sources)
- Other topics: community-based EOL care, citizens arriving from out-of-state





Recap VT Children's Hospital Information (3/25)

- Youngest VT case = 20 y.o. Children as proportion of overall cases remains very low (nationally)
- Pre-test probability of COVID-19 for children presenting with respiratory symptoms remains low
- PPE recommendations in flux at other institutions
- Guidance for HCWs with sick children at home: children stay home; healthy HCWs may work; consider testing only child with significant symptoms (fever, cough, SOB)
- Implications of NY state order to self-quarantine for 14 days upon arrival at new destination

New VDH Information/Resources (Breena)
