Surgical Subspecialties	<i>4 weeks / 4 credits</i>
SURG 9550 x2, or 4 weeks of a single subspecialty. A Surgery Acting Internship (AI) may be used to satisfy either the second AI requirement or the Surgery Subspecialty Requirement, but not both. Anesthesia may only be used toward 2 weeks of this requirement. <i>Must be done within the UVMHN, at WCHN Campus, or an Affiliate Site.</i>	
Teaching Practicum or Scholarly Project	<i>4 weeks / 4 credits</i>
Students, excluding Surgery Majors, may be eligible for an exemption; if you receive an exemption from the Teaching Practicum/Scholarly Project requirement, you will be expected to complete an elective in its place. Surgery Majors may not receive an exemption and are required to complete a Scholarly Project in Surgery.	
Elective rotations	<i>28 weeks total</i>
Students in the <i>Surgery Major</i> must take SURG 9511 Surgery Resident Readiness and associated pre-assignments, and complete an Anatomy requirement. ¹ Students may include 4 weeks of MD 1080 USMLE Study time to prepare for Step 2.
