

Camtasia Installation Requests

<u>Camtasia</u> is software made to record and / or narrate the activity on your computer screen. The Larner College of Medicine (LCOM) is deploying this software to faculty for the creation of curriculum modules used in medical student education.

LCOM faculty wishing to use Camtasia have the following deployment options:

- 1. Contact COMTS to borrow one of our tablet computer kits that include a touch-screen enabled laptop with digital pen (Windows 10), mouse, and headset with microphone as well as the Camtasia application.
- 2. Contact COMTS for installation of Camtasia on your UVM/LCOM computer (Windows or MacOS). This option also includes an optional install on a home or personal machine.
- 3. If your computer is owned by UVM Health, contact COMTS to arrange the installation of Camtasia on either your UVM Health-owned machine **OR** your personal computer (Windows or MacOS).
- Non-faculty who need this software for the creation of teaching materials for LCOM students may take advantage of option 1 above.
- Faculty at Eastern Maine Medical Center or Western Connecticut Health Network who need this software for the creation of teaching materials for LCOM students will be provided with a tablet computer kit to borrow as needed (see option 1 above.)
