- Lund was founded in 1890 as 'The Home for Friendless Women' and has adapted over the past 128 years in response to the most pressing needs of women, children and
- families in the community.
- Lund is a statewide organization with a presence in every single county in Vermont.
- For the last four years, all babies born at Lund have been born free of illicit substances.
- Since 2000, Project Family has found homes for over 4,340
- children and teenagers.
- Lund's residential progam is the only place in Vermont where moms can engage in treatment while living with their children.
- Last year, Lund served over 5,400 individuals.
