- Lund was founded in 1890 as ‘The Home for Friendless Women’ and has adapted over the past 128 years in response to the most pressing needs of women, children and families in the community.
- Lund is a statewide organization with a presence in every single county in Vermont.
- For the last four years, all babies born at Lund have been born free of illicit substances.
- Since 2000, Project Family has found homes for over 4,340 children and teenagers.
- Lund’s residential program is the only place in Vermont where moms can engage in treatment while living with their children.
- Last year, Lund served over 5,400 individuals.
