NEGEA Student and Resident Travel Stipends

Purpose

NEGEA Student Travel Stipends support students to attend the Annual NEGEA Conference. The amount of 2017 travel stipends is \$400, which is meant to (partially) cover expenses related to attendance at the Annual NEGEA Conference, such as registration fee, travel, and lodging. Up to 10 travel stipends will be awarded.

Eligibility

Any student or resident currently within an NEGEA-affiliated institution who will attend the 2017 NEGEA Education Retreat is eligible to apply for a travel stipend. Awards will be considered for those with accepted abstracts and who will serve as the primary presenter of their work.

To be considered for a travel stipend the student or resident must submit the following:

- 1. Current CV which contains contact information
- 2. Personal Statement
- 3. Abstract or description of the work to be presented

Personal Statement Guidelines

The Personal Statement of 250 words or less should focus on how attendance at this meeting will foster professional development.

Submission Guidelines

Materials should be submitted via email attachments to Norma Saks, Chair of the NEGEA Awards Committee (norma.saks@rwjms.rutgers.edu)

All files should be saved with the applicant's name, e.g. CarolCapelloCV.doc and CarolCapelloPersonalStatement.doc

Applications for the NEGEA Student Travel Stipends will be accepted at any time throughout the abstract submission and acceptance process. The deadline for applications is <u>March 1</u>.

Winners of the travel stipend will be notified following the notification of abstract acceptances for the meeting.
