#### **COMMUNITY SERVICE**

**UVM Farm-to-Clinic Program** – Despite the demonstrated efficacy of medication-assisted treatment for opioid dependence, one potentially adverse side effect may include weight gain and/or high sugar consumption, which may be mediated by pharmacologic changes to taste preference. Starting in July 2015, our lab collaborated with Burlington's Intervale Community Farm to bring a weekly subscription of healthy, free produce to patients maintained on buprenorphine or methadone at the Chittenden Clinic. I helped coordinate and run the UVM Farm-to-Clinic stand initiative to distribute fresh, locally-grown produce to patients from the clinic waiting room every Tuesday from July-November 2016.
