

Lund offers family-centered and trauma-informed outpatient treatment services to clients struggling with substance use and/or mental health challenges. Issues addressed include, but are not limited to, opiate or other drug addition, alcohol, dependence, anxiety, depression, and PTSD.

We offer services to adolescents and adults, and work with both men and women, who are either pregnant or actively parenting.
