The Health Department is **offering free and fast COVID-19 testing at the sites listed above for anyone without symptoms, especially health care workers, first responders, and child care providers serving essential workers.** This clinic is part of the State of Vermont's efforts to ramp up testing and prevent the spread of COVID-19. **The test will tell you if you have a current infection.** It is not a serology/antibody test, which means it will not tell you if you were infected in the past.
