If you are interested in learning more about research, consider joining the Research Emphasis for Medical Students.

This optional Emphasis started in early 2017 and is comprised of several components including a rolling 2-year monthly curriculum, journal clubs, opportunities to participate in "real-life" aspects of research (e.g. observe the process of clinical trial design), and resources for finding research projects and mentoring throughout the University.

The 2-year curriculum includes workshops, hand-on sessions, and seminars on clinical, translational, and basic science research topics to improve your research knowledge and skills. While these sessions used to occur in person, we have move to a strictly pre-recorded format for online viewing to allow the most flexibility. Students can join the Emphasis at any time during their training.
