The Freeman School is now offering a unique opportunity for medical students to complete an MBA prior to joining a residency program. This one-year program is designed for graduating medical students who were either unsuccessful on Match Day or were looking for an opportunity to complete an MBA in one year prior to going on to a residency program.

The special program allows students to complete the Freeman Schools Professional MBA in three semesters. The program starts in June 2017 and the students graduate in May, 2018. The program is build directly from our highly successful accelerated joint MD/MBA degree and our extensive experience providing business education to medical students, residents and practicing physicians. The program is structured to allow students to participate in residency interviews and visits.

The program is designed to provide medical professionals with the tools they need to succeed in todays challenging healthcare industry.
